Eager to find out more about God, Nabila continued to watch Derek Prince's videos daily. Then one day she sent a prayer request via e-mail to our Middle East outreach team.

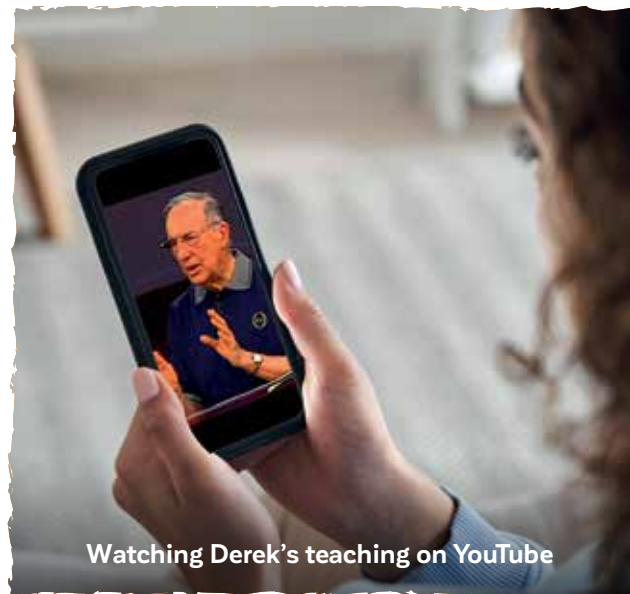
Our workers put her in touch with pastor Ashraf and his wife Salma in Lebanon, who met with Nabila to pray with her and disciple her on a regular basis.


