Emergency Action Plan

Held under British Rowing's Rules of Racing and British Rowing's Row Safe: A Guide to Good Practice in Rowing ("Row Safe")

Process for summoning help in an emergency:

- 1. Nearest official/umpire made aware.
- 2. Said official/umpire will radio to the onsite medical cover/safety team and offer assistance.
- 3. Medical and safety team takeover management of emergency assisted by organising committee and umpires.

Location of Event: Blenheim Palace (Lake West of Palace), Woodstock, OX20 1PP.

Sign posted from all major roads, North of Oxford on the A44.

In an emergency please call 999 or 112 from your mobile – there is a landline available at the Palace gift shop – approx. 500m from the landing stage.

St Johns ambulance is situated in the supporter's area. Casualties will be transported to the ambulance by foot if they are able. Otherwise by safety boat, stretcher or vehicle. We will have a minimum of 2 safety boats on the lake at all times. There are 8 marshals/umpires stationed at: boating area, start line, finish line and 5 circulating with the crews.

In the event of a fire all competitors and spectators must meet in front of the main gates to the palace (next to the gift shop).
