## Harness Attachment Guide Series 2000

The harness is separated into shoulder straps and waist belt. You will need 1 X CP Harness Pin (334728)

### To fit the shoulder straps:

- 1. With the buckles of the shoulder straps facing towards you, thread the ~10cm long central fixing strap through the central fixing points.

  Feed CP Harness Pin (334728) through the loop at the end to hold in place (A).

  2. For each of the tightening straps, feed through the fixing points on each side of the blue skirt then through the loop at the end of the strap (B) and tighten (C).
- 3. Feed the end of the strap now attached to the skirt to the back of the middle slot of each buckle (D) and pull back through the bottom slot to fix and allow for tightening (E).



1. With the buckles facing the sprayer, feed each of the loose ends through the grooves in the skirt (F), fix the end to the buckle and tighten (G). NB. The waist belt takes weight off the shoulders and should be used to aid both comfort and safety.





# Harness Attachment Guide Classic


The harness is separated into shoulder straps and waist belt. You will need 2 X CP Harness Pin (334728)

### To fit the shoulder straps:

- 1. With the buckles of the shoulder straps facing towards you, thread the two fixing straps down through the central fixing points. Feed one CP Harness Pin (334728) through each loop at the end to hold in place (A).
- 2. For each of the tightening straps, feed through the fixing points on each side of the blue skirt then through the loop at the end of the strap (B) and tighten.
- 3. Feed the end of the strap now attached to the skirt to the back of the middle slot of each buckle and pull back through the bottom slot to fix and allow for tightening (C).

#### To fit the waist belt:

1. With the buckles facing the sprayer, feed each of the loose ends through the same fixing points at either side of the skirt as used to attach the tightening shoulder straps, fix the end to the buckle and tighten (D). NB. The waist belt takes weight off the shoulders and should be used to aid both comfort and safety.



This harness has been designed for the Classic and Series 2000 variants of Cooper Pegler sprayer.

They are however not manufactured by Cooper Pegler and are therefore not covered under their warranty conditions.
